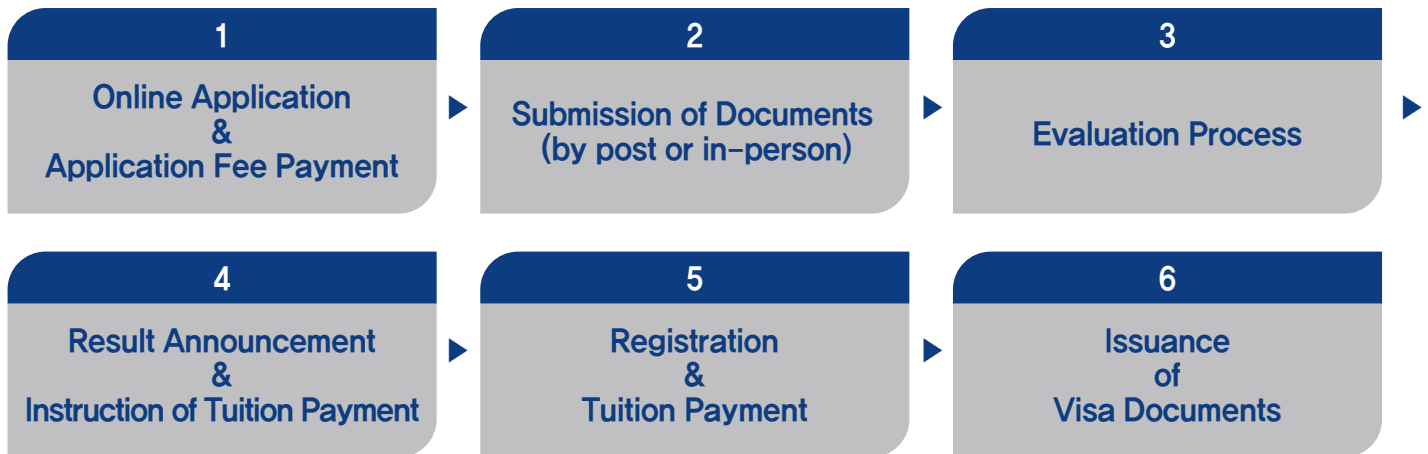

- ※ Interviews (by phone or so) can be conducted upon departmental request. Departments in Arts and Physical Education will or may request applicants to take both an interview and a performance test.

 - Application and screening will not be processed without payment of application fee.
 - The remitter's name must be IDENTICAL to the applicant's name.
 - ※ Application materials and application fees are non-refundable.

04 Eligibility

Applicants must meet one of the followings: (one of the two conditions below:)

1. An applicant whose both parents hold citizenship other than the Republic of Korea
(Non-Korean applicant with Non-Korean parents)
2. Applicant(foreign citizens) who has completed his/her entire official education outside of Korea
(from elementary to higher education (bachelor's degree))

- ※ Applicants can apply for any department regardless of their academic area of previous degree.
- ※ Applicants who hold either a Bachelor of Medicine or a Bachelor of Dental Clinic degree are eligible to apply for Clinical Medicine Field of Medical Science. Applicants who do not hold a degree from the medical field are eligible to obtain a Master of Science or Ph.D. in Science degree.
- ※ Full-time professors at Yeungnam University are not eligible for Graduate School admission.
- ※ International Professors for Education at the Chunma College of General Studies, Yeugnam University are eligible to apply for the Graduate Program at Yeungnam University.

■ Eligibility for Language Proficiency

– Applicants must meet one of the following language proficiency criteria :

- ① Korean : TOPIK Level 3 or higher
 - ② English : TOEFL iBT 71, IELTS 5.5, CEFR B2, NEW TEPS 326 or TOEIC 700 or higher
 - ③ Applicants who are able to pursue lectures in Korean or English without the above specified certified language proficiency test score
- ※ In case of ③, each department shall evaluate and determine applicant's language proficiency through the departmental screening process or interview.

■ Note

※ Requirement of Language Proficiency for Graduation

- Students must meet one of the following Korean language proficiency for graduation :
 - a. acquiring TOPIK (Korean Language Proficiency Test) level 4 or higher
 - b. taking the special Korean classes at the Yeungnam University Korean Language Institute and pass the level 2 or higher class
 - c. pass the Korean Language Test by the Yeungnam University Graduate School

05 Required Documents

- All required documents must be kept ready and submitted before the submission deadline.
 - * If unable to present the original hard copy of apostille or consular confirmed documents within the application deadline due to an unexpected situation arises, please first submit notarized copy, then prepare and re-submit with confirmed hard copies before May 17, 2024.
 - * Applicants shall be responsible for any consequences caused by not following the above.
- All documents must be submitted to the Graduate School Office either by post or in person by May 10, 2024.
 - * E-mail submissions are not permitted.
- All required documents without stapled or clip must be submitted in the order of the list below.
- The documents in any other foreign languages other than Korean and English must be translated into Korean or English and notarized before submission.
- It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that all required application materials are submitted.
- **ALL submitted documents including supporting materials will NOT be returned to the applicants. We advise applicants to prepare additional documentation for VISA applications.**

06 Notes for Application

• Information on Applicant

- ▶ Your name in English and date of birth should be identical with the information on your passport.
- ▶ Contact information(e-mail address and phone number) must be accurate.
(※ Important notices and information on admission will be delivered to the applicant's e-mail address on the application form)
- ▶ Applicants should correctly select the applying degree program, department and major area.
- ▶ Missing or false information shall put the applicants at disadvantages in the process of evaluation and the submitted application documents (materials) and application fee will not be refunded.
- ▶ Please double-check the application information before completing the process.

• Admission Cancellation

- ▶ If a violation is found or required documents are not submitted, admission procedures will be canceled.
- ▶ In case that the admitted, applicant who has submitted a certificate of expectant graduation in application, the applicant who will have graduated from a university abroad must submit the applicant's certificate of graduation or degree diploma and transcript (refer to page 4) by July 2 (Tue), 2024, and applicants who will have graduated from a university in Korea by August 23 (Fri), 2024. If not, admission will be canceled.
- ▶ Acceptance will be canceled if the admitted student fails to enter Korea by the deadline set by the university.

• Note

- ▶ Admission-related matters not specified in these guidelines shall follow the rules and regulations set by Graduate School Steering Committee and Graduate School Committee of Yeungnam University.

07 Scholarship

1) Scholarship Assessment

- ▶ All scholarships must pass scholarship assessments.
- ▶ Even after admission, scholarship eligibility is determined through recommendations and assessments, and students must apply for scholarships each semester.
- ▶ Scholarships may be downward even if the student has submitted a language test score below.

2) Scholarship Beneficiary Requirements

- ▶ The candidates of scholarship must meet the requirements below or the specification in page 9.
- ▶ All of international students are required to have the National Health Insurance of Korea and individual health insurance (private insurance) for the candidates of scholarship.

3) Application of Scholarship Criteria

- ▶ Scholarships apply only to tuition fee.
- ▶ Admission fees are not covered by scholarship.
- ▶ Language proficiency for scholarship eligibility is based on officially recognized language test scores; institution-specific tests like Institutional TOEFL are not accepted. Validity of test date must be within two (2) years from May 3, 2024.
- ▶ Recipients of Scholarships A~E must assist in teaching for up to 10 hours per week during the semester.
- ▶ International Professors for Education at the College of Basic Studies, Yeungnam University are only available to Scholarship K.

4) Others

- ▶ Beneficiaries of scholarship A to E shall be scholarship K beneficiaries from the second semester if any of the followings is applicable:
 - Those who have obtained at least one (1) course subject with grade of C or less on the grades completed in the previous semester
 - Those with GPA of less than 3.0 in the previous semester

5) Scholarship programs are subject to change in accordance to the university policy.

1. Yeungnam University will send admission materials including the "Certificate of Admission" to applicants by post.
2. Applicants apply for "Student Visa" with the received and required documents at the Embassy or Consulate of the Republic of Korea in the applicant's country.
3. Applicants obtain "Student Visa" (D-2) and enter Korea.
